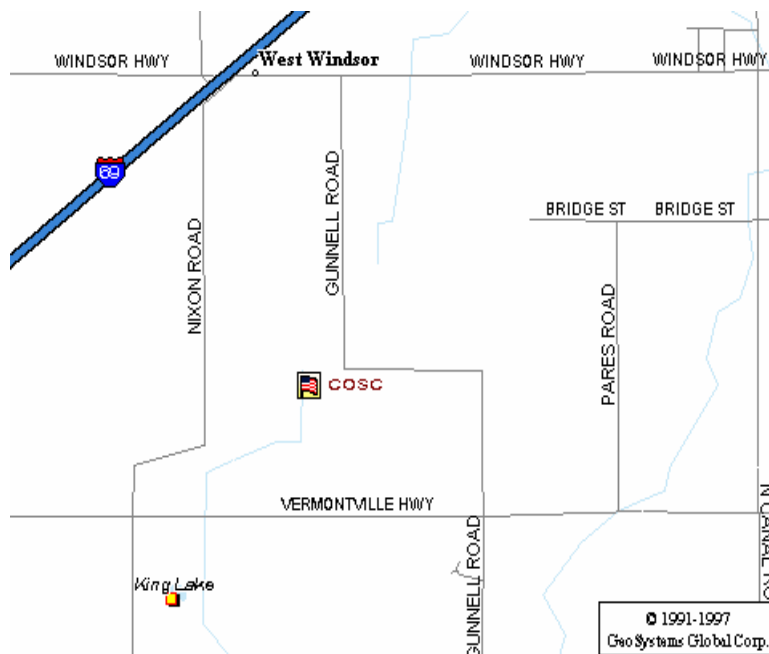

COSC'S 28th ANNUAL PRIMITIVE/MILITARY SHOOT – May 15, 2010

We moved the shoot to a Saturday this year and hopefully, better weather. This year there will again be three phases of shooting: Team, Individual, and Primitive matches. Naturally, everyone who enters will be shooting the primitive only once, as that score figures into both the Individual and Team Aggregates. The fee this year will be **\$10.00 per shooter**. We will be awarding our traveling Team Trophy, the Pa Keeler Memorial Primitive Match Trophy, a Steve Brown Memorial Trophy for Shotgun and 1st Place money award and groceries. Appropriate historical dress encouraged, but not required.

PA KEELER MEMORIAL PRIMITIVE MATCH

10-15 shots at 10 to 100 yards +?

Shooters should verify their score before leaving primitive area, except for the single shoot-off shot which will be scored by the official scorer.

Primitive score will be added to both Team and Individual Aggregates.

Awards will be a **special trophy** and groceries.

COURSE OF FIRE FOR THE INDIVIDUAL MATCH

5 shots at 25 yards, 5 shots at 50 yards, and 5 shots at 100 yards,
all fired at NMLRA-style animal targets

Each relay will be 30 minutes long.

10-15 shot primitive course

Awards will be money prize for first and groceries.

COURSE OF FIRE FOR THE 4-SHOOTER TEAM MATCH

3 shots per shooter at 50 yards at clay pigeons and target.

3 shots per shooter at 100 yards at animal target

As in the past, team members will have to shoot together as they will be firing at only one target

10-15 shots per shooter on the primitive course

Awards will be the **traveling trophy** plus groceries

We are having **Muzzleloader Trap** activity again this year in memory of Steve Brown who passed away in March. Your entry fee of \$10 covers Relay #1 of 20 birds. \$2.50 cost per each match 2 - 10.
