


NWT Richmond Skirmish

July 12-14, 2024



The 1st Michigan Infantry and 15th Virginia Cavalry invite all NWT units to attend the three day skirmish at the **Richmond Sportsman's Club located at 9134 Big Hand Road, Columbus, MI**. Camping opens at 5:00pm on Thursday, July 11. Ground fires are allowed but pits must be filled with no wood chunks left behind. **No Food service will be available**. Skirmishers are asked to bring their own water and take trash home for disposal. The dumpster on site is reserved for broken targets and other range debris.

All N-SSA rules will be in effect throughout the weekend. Individual events will be classified per NWT classifications, with places paid accordingly.

We will be using a five-person team format for the musket and carbine matches and you must have three unit members to constitute a legal team. You must have two unit members for legal three-person smoothbore team.

Please return all un-hit targets to the ready area. Also, there will be marked containers to recycle the yellow pigeon ties. Please help the region with this effort.

FRIDAY , July 12

At 1:00pm the range opens for individuals and closes at 5:00pm. All targets are five shots. Relays will be 15 minutes in duration. First target purchased for each event will be \$2. Re-entry targets are \$1 each. Aggregate matches are \$1 and must be declared and paid for with the first entry. No protests for individual targets will be accepted after 5:00pm, Saturday, July 13.

PLEASE NOTE: This is a 50 yard range and the frames must be against the berm. There will be selected times during individual match relays that only 25 yard targets can be shot.

10 hanging clay pigeons

5 7" paper plates on a backer (three minute event)

10 dye-filled water bottles plus 1 moskeet (rolling thunder)

30 minutes (approx.) after conclusion of carbine match:

Smoothbore Team match (three-member)

9 clay pigeons on a backer (25 yards)

6 hanging 4"x4" tiles “

6 hanging clay pigeons “

5 hanging 6" x 6"tiles (50 yards)

SUNDAY, July 14

9:00am Musket Team commander's meeting at the tower

9:20am (approx.) Opening ceremonies

9:30am **Musket Team** match (all events at 50 yards)

EVENTS:

20 clay pigeons on a backer

10 hanging 4" x 4" tiles

10 hanging clay pigeons

5 7" paper plates on a backer (three minute event)

10 dye-filled water bottles plus 1 pot silhouette (rolling thunder)
